Nation, Citizenship and Race in Canada, 1802-1919

Celebrating 150 years of a Canadian state provokes the question of why? Why do we remember 1867 as the year of founding a white nation state – namely as an imperial dominion – whereas indigenous nations had been living there for much longer? The lecture takes up this challenge by asking for the potential of the inclusion and exclusion of citizenship in Canada in the 19th and early 20th centuries.
