Remit:

We are seeking for our project "Professional Perception of Teaching Staff" which is funded within the Quality Offensive in Teachers Education funded by the BMBF (German Ministry of Education and Research) a researcher holding a graduate degree. The goal of the project is to study the professional perception of teachers in education during decision-making processes in a virtual environment. Work packages include:

- design and realisation of the required studies for investigation of professional perception in a virtual environment
- acquisition and processing of data from motion analysis in the mentioned investigations
- publication of the results in peer reviewed international journals and on conferences
- preparation of a PhD thesis on basis of results of the investigations
- collaboration in acquisition of third party funding
- collaboration in demands of the professorship for Exercise Science

Requirements:

- Master degree or comparable certificate in sport science, biomedicine or medicine technology with at least good result
- founded knowledge in experimental scientific research, in application of biomechanical and physiological methods (e.g. cinematic, eye tracking, dynamometry) and statistical data evaluation
- competence and interest in handling of virtual reality with the GRAIL-System
- excellent research and communication skills in English and German are necessary
- willingness to work on a scientific qualification (PhD-Thesis) on basis of the collected data is wished
